




#### WHERE WAS HE BORN?

David (Davy) Crockett (born August 17, 1786 - died March 6, 1836) was an <u>American frontiersman</u>, <u>bear hunter</u>, sharpshooter, <u>soldier</u>, <u>legislator</u>, and folk hero. Davy was born in a cabin near <u>Limestone</u>, <u>Tennessee</u> (in eastern Tennessee)



After the Independence War ended in 1781, the Americans in large numbers poured into the west. In some areas they had to battle the Indian tribes. American frontier militiamen under <u>Andrew Jackson</u> defeated the Creeks and opened the

## WAS HE A CONGRESSMAN?

Colonel Crockett went on to serve in the Tennessee legislature from 1821 to 1824, and represented Tennessee in the U.S. Congress from 1827 to 1831 and from 1833 to 1835.

When his political career ended in 1836 (after he lost his last election for Congress), Crockett took his family to <u>Texas</u>. Texas had recently declared its independence from Mexico.



#### THE END

Crockett and almost 200 other Texan volunteers died on March 6, 1836, after unsuccessfully defending the Alamo (a mission in San Antonio, Texas) for 13 days against an army of thousands of Mexican soldiers led by General Antonio Lopez de Santa Anna


In 1813 he joined a Regiment in the war against the Indians.


